### **What Is Oil Absorbent Material?**

“Oil absorbent material” refers to any product that is used to absorb waste oil from any source. The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resource’s (DNR) definition of oil absorbent material includes:

- Granular “kitty litter” absorbents
- Oil-dry cloths, rags and wipes
- Paper toweling
- Absorbent pillows, socks, pigs and pads

### **What Is Waste Oil?**

“Waste oil” is defined as petroleum-derived or synthetic oil that has been used or spilled, such as:

- Engine oils
- Transmission fluid
- Metalworking fluids and oils
- Hydraulic fluid
- Industrial process oils

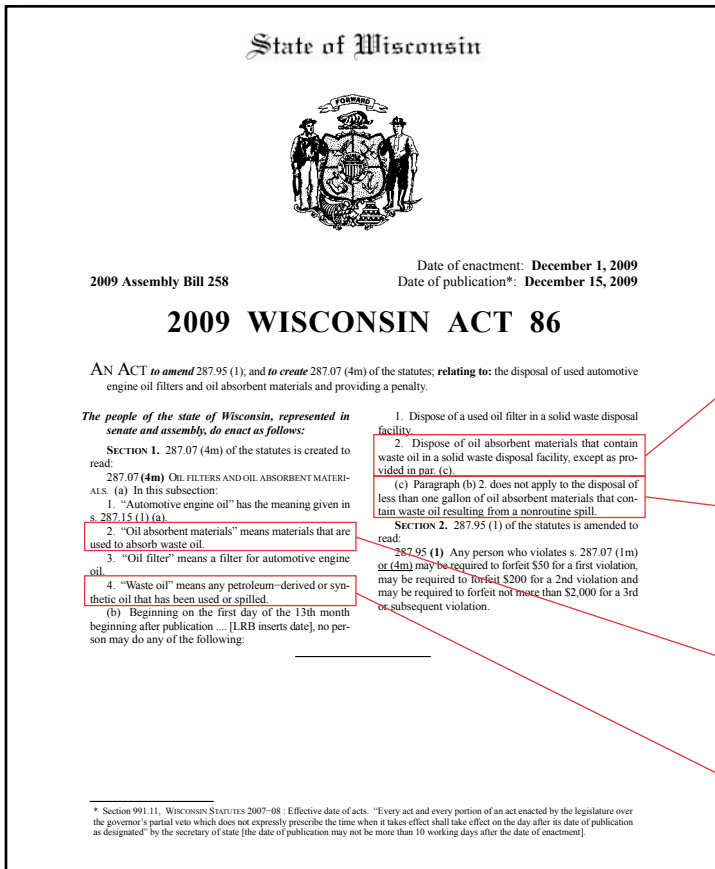
